



NOTIFICATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COURTS
RE: INTENT ON ADMINISTRATION IN GOOD FAITH OF THE OFFICE
OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COURTS

I, Mr. Atichoke Pholdee, Secretary-General of the Office of the Administrative Courts, together with executives of the Office of the Administrative Courts, Administrative Court officials, and personnel of the Office of the Administrative Courts, hereby declare our sincere intent that the Office shall cherish the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy and working precepts of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej The Great and the oath of accession of His Majesty King Maha Vajiralongkorn Phra Vajiraklaochaoyuhua stating “I shall continue, preserve and build upon the royal legacy, and shall reign with righteousness for the benefit and happiness of the people forever.” The Office of the Administrative Courts shall follow these principles to bring benefit to the nation by performing its duties with honesty, good governance, correctness and righteousness so as to yield maximum benefit to the organization, the public, society and the nation by carrying out its duties according to the following guidelines:

1. To focus on achievement and work outcomes, to perform duties with honesty and in accordance with the principles of good governance, to uphold the public interest, and to be accountable and responsible for work performance;
2. To improve work methods and procedures; to provide standardized service in order that the public and those receiving services shall be able to easily, promptly, transparently and equitably access administrative justice; and
3. To adhere to the Administrative Court Culture (TRUST) and promote a “Happy Organization”, to educate and promote ethical values and attitudes that oppose corruption and to not tolerate any form of corruption.
